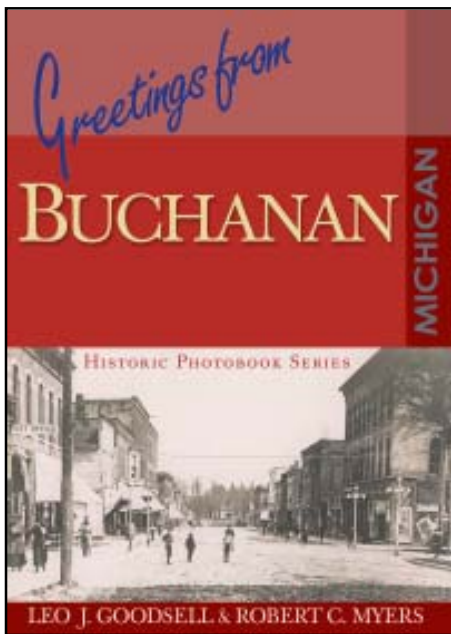

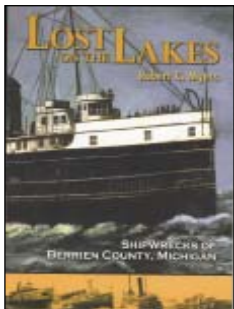

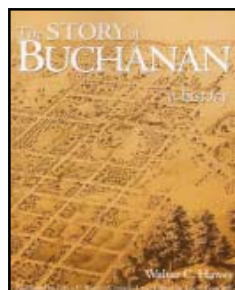

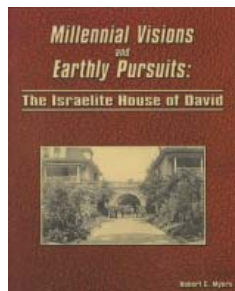

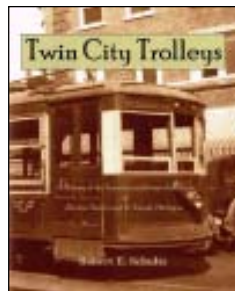

From his research, Walter Hawes detailed the history of Buchanan from the prehistoric period through the 1920s. in a splendid series of articles published from 1951-1954 in the *Berrien County Record*. This book is the first compilation of his work into a single volume. 7 x 9", 186 pp., softcover, with bibliography & index. \$14.95.



Millennial Visions and Earthly Pursuits: The Israelite House of David by Robert C. Myers. This book traces the history of the Israelite House of David in Benton Harbor. The booklet is 8-1/2 x 11", softcover, 31 pp. with bibliography & illustrations. \$8.95.
